



## Marcus Eatmon

March 21, 1928 - October 28, 2024

Marcus Eatmon was born March 21, 1928 to the union of Marcus Eatmon Sr. and Elizabeth Finch, From this union, Mary Elizabeth, a daughter and James P. Eatmon, a second son, was also born. These family members, along with Bennie Eatmon, a nephew, all preceded him in death.

Marcus graduated from Lanier High School in Jackson, Mississippi. He later attended Tougaloo College until illness caused him to drop out. He came to Chicago in 1948 at the age of twenty and Joined Local 1 as a caretaker of buildings. Marcus was able to gain knowledge and insight of many trades due to the kindness and loving concern of journeymen of all sorts. This enabled him to make a decent living.

In the twilight of his life, he was introduced to a well known religious group, called Jehovah's Witnesses. After studying with them for a few years, Marcus came to be convinced that this was the one true religion of the One True God Jehovah. On July 14, 1990 he was baptized and became a member of the Windsor Park Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses a few blocks from his home.

Many enjoyed Marcus' company as he would frequently open his home for visits and hospitality. He loved sweets and enjoyed baking and sharing his delicious treats. His generosity was clear from the way he helped others and

the many donations he made to various charities.

He leaves behind to cherish his memory a loving great niece Benae Eatmon (Conway, Arkansas) and her son, Travis O'Bannon (Charlotte, North Carolina) as well as a great nephew, LaRon Jamison (Menifee, Arkansas), his caregivers , and the Windsor Park Congregation. Marcus Eatmon also leaves behind to mourn his death a host of first and second cousins on his mother's side of the family (the Finch family), including Alfred Finch, Carolyn Finch, George G. Finch and George T. Finch, as well as numerous additional family members in all parts of the United States.
