Willie G. Noble was born to proud parents Annie and Green Noble on January 15, 1917 in Sunnyvale, Mississippi and was raised in Amory, Mississippi. He was the oldest of four siblings, sisters Marie Moore, Cecilia (Cetabel) Jefferson and one brother Murdophus Noble. All have preceded him in death.

It was in his hometown of Amory, Mississippi where he met and married Lillian Jackson. Together they shared a loving relationship based on deep friendship and respect. They were united in Holy Matrimony on June 11, 1940. To this loving union, seven children were born. His wife and one son, Dennis preceded him in death.

Willie G. confessed his faith and accepted Jesus Christ at an early age.

Willie G is remembered as a family man and loved spending time with them. He had a commitment to his family, supporting them in all their endeavors.

Willie G was educated in Monroe County where he graduated from Monroe County Training High School and subsequently attended annual class

He and his wife ran a Ma & Pa grocery store at 5959 S. Morgan for 10 years.
